The Selectmen discussed the Abatement process. Mike Fournier from Brett Pervis and Associates will be here on Wednesday to start the abatement process. So far we have received applications for 14 abatements not counting the ones for the Power Company.

The Selectmen discussed having the State Police patrol the town for us instead of hiring an Officer. Todd Cohen has told them that we can hire State Police for a 4 to 6 hour block of time. We need to contact Twin Mountain to set this up. The Selectmen thought that this would be a good plan. It was discussed that they would have to do something about a Dog Officer as State Police would not handle that job.
