

Selectmen's Meeting  
April 13, 2010

All Selectmen Present  
Meeting started at 7:00P.M.

There was a contest for the best poster for recycling; the student with the best poster won a \$50.00 savings bond. Eileen Brown, Marilyn Bedell, Cindy Frazer, Jessica Sherman and Mary Elise Thomas judged the posters; this was very hard as we had three dozen good posters. In the end we picked two posters and Eileen Brown donated a \$50.00 savings bond as well as Cindy Frazer. The Selectmen presented the two winners with the gift certificates for the savings bond; one went to Will Dimas and the other to Danielle Martin. All of the posters are on display in the Town Hall, please stop by and look at them.

Ed Milnor was in to see the Selectmen about doing a lot line adjustment. He was told that he did not need to send letters to the abutters but the Planning Board would have to do the approval of it.

Bryan Turnbull was in to see the Selectmen about the recycling. He has worked out a schedule for the hours and days he thinks it should be open. He asked if the Town crew had any interest in working at this. Bruce said he did not think they wanted to do this job but he will ask again just to make sure. The Selectmen signed building permits for Gerry Laflamme, and Becky Emerson.

The Selectmen discussed the work that still needs to be done at the clinic. They had received a letter from Beth at the clinic wondering when they were going to finish the jobs. Bruce will stop in and see Beth to see exactly what still needs to be done. The Selectmen will write up the specs for the work needed for drainage around the building and mail out letters to the local contractors.

Pete's Rubbish contacted Cindy about the trash pick up. We have a resident in town who is not putting the trash by the road but leaving it half way down the driveway. Cindy sent a letter explain that the trash needs to be bagged and tied as well as by the road or it will not be picked up.
