August 18, 2009

All Selectmen Present

Meeting started at 7:00 P.M.

Tom Maguire and Karl Johnson were in to talk to the Selectmen. Tom introduced himself to Bob and Gerry as they had not yet met. They discussed how to tell if someone is a resident of the town.
