January 26, 2010

Bob Wormer and Bruce Frazer Present
Meeting started at 7:00 P.M.

The Selectmen signed the manifests; they also signed a letter authorizing the Trustee's to pay George Sansoucy PE, LLE \$2,745.00 from the Assessing Fund.

Glenn Fearon came in to discuss changing the meetings for the Planning Board to the first Monday of the month. One of the members is unable to make meetings on Thursday nights. Bob is the Selectmen representative on the Planning Board and they agreed to change the meetings to the first Monday of the month at 7:00 P.M. Bob asked Cindy to call Tara Bamford at North Country Council to let her know as she is working on the Master Plan with them. Laurie Theriault had asked about having the 4-H deliver the Town Reports to the people in town as we will not be mailing them this year. The Selectmen suggested that Cindy call Michelle Norko and see if they would be interested in doing this.

The Selectmen discussed the warrant article for the Elderly Exemption. The Town of Monroe has always been \$5,000.00 and they are going to put in a warrant article to up that amount. Ron Cote from the Department of Revenue came up and explained how it worked to Bruce.

The Selectmen discussed people paying bills here at the town office or leaving checks or cash for other offices. It was decided that a receipt needs to be given to anyone giving cash or check for other departments.

Bruce Frazer made a motion to go into nonpublic session for Direct Assistance issues at 8:10P.M., Bob Wormer seconded, both in favor. Bob Wormer made a motion to come out of nonpublic session at 8:35P.M., Bruce seconded both in favor.

The Selectmen talked about putting a vault in at the old Fire Station. The town is running out of space in the Town hall building and something will need to be done. They are waiting on an estimate for the cost of building one than they will decide if they want to do a warrant article for it this year.
