Selectmen's meeting  
Bob Wormer and Bruce Frazer present  
Meeting started at 7:00P.M.

The Selectmen signed the manifests, they signed two intents to cut, one for Bruce & Cindy Frazer and one for Dan & Jan Powers. The Selectmen also approved three use of Town Hall Contracts, one for Mary Elise Thomas, Barbara Farr and Russell Brown.

PJ Blanchard was in to see the Selectmen about the streetlights. There are some lights that need to be removed and he wondered if the Selectmen had done anything about it. The Selectmen apologized for not getting that job done and said they would work on it.

Nick Vosnick was in to see the Selectmen about the skating rink. He was wondering about getting more lighting at the rink. The Selectmen agreed to look into the lighting situation. Nick also wanted to know when the skating shack would be unlocked. The Selectmen had discussed having adults sign out the key as they do for the town hall. After some discussion it was decided to unlock the building and if there is a problem the building will be locked for good. Nick also stated that he had offered to leave his hockey net there for other peoples use. The Selectmen told him he should not leave it there.

The Selectmen discussed the use of tables and chairs from the town hall. They have decided to draw up a contract for people to sign for use of town property.

The Selectmen went over the 2010 budget again. They are still working on fine tuning the budget.

The Selectmen signed a contract with Cartographies in Littleton for another year. This is the company that does our town maps.

The Selectmen will be meeting with the Budget Committee on January 19, 2010 to go over the 2010 budget. The Public Hearing for the Town will be February 2nd and Town Meeting will be March 9, 2010.

Russell Brown had talked to Cindy about the fire ponds; he was wondering who was responsible for keeping them assessable in the winter. The Selectmen said that they have never been assessable in the winter unless they are on the edge of the road. They do not believe they have ever been plowed out.
