Signed manifests, signed building permit for Charles Hammer, signed new cemetery rules, and signed a one year contract with Woodsville Water and Light.

The Selectmen looked at the bids for paving Mountain View Drive and Pine Hill. Bids were received from Blaktop, Bigelow and Pike. Pike was awarded the job.

Gerry said he had been asked by some residents about trash pickup. Some people's trash was not being picked up. Cindy told him she had also had a few calls about this and believes the reason is that the trash is not being bagged and Pete's Rubbish will not pick it up unless it is in a bag. The Selectmen asked Cindy to put a notice in the Bridge Weekly stating that all trash needs to be bagged or Pete's Rubbish will not pick it up.

Marilyn gave the Selectmen a list of people who have still not registered their dogs. The Selectmen authorized sending letters to these people; they will have to pay the registration fee, plus the penalty and a \$25.00 fine.

Deb Clough called and talked to Bob Wormer about putting another gate in at the North Monroe Cemetery. Bob told her the Selectmen had discussed it and decided that it wasn't necessary. She also requested that a trash pail be put at the North Monroe Cemetery. The Selectmen agreed that one should be there. They will get one up there as soon as possible.
