

Selectmen's Meeting  
May 12, 2009  
All Selectmen Present  
Meeting started at 7:00PM

Joseph and Helen Laberge were in to discuss the appraisal on their home. They feel that the appraisal is too high and wanted to know what they could do about it. They were told at this point there is nothing they can do, they need to wait until the next tax bill comes out and then they can file an abatement. Abatement forms have to be in by March 1st.
