

Selectmen's meeting
November 16, 2009
Bruce Frazer & Bob Wormer present
Meeting started at 7:00 P.M.

The Selectmen signed the manifests, they also signed a letter authorizing the Trustees to pay Blaktop \$220.92 from the Town Hall Paving Fund, George E Sansoucy \$812.50 from the Assessing Fund and to pay Avitar Associates of New England \$2,688.00 from the Assessing Fund.

Betti Ward was in to see the Selectmen about her tax bill. She was being charged for more acres than she has from 2002 through 2007. She is also being taxed on a building that she has not had for three years. The Selectmen told her that she would need to file an abatement for the newest tax bill and they will get together with Keith and the Assessor to see what to do about the rest of it.

Betti Ward also asked the Selectmen to reconsider putting some gate back in the North Monroe Cemetery. She feels that a lot of elderly people go there and it would be safer for them if they had the gates back in there.

Warren Witcher was in to talk to the Selectmen about his tax bill. He feels he is being overtaxed on his building. The Selectmen told him to fill out an abatement and return it to this office.

The Selectmen signed a contract with Lyndonville Office Supply for the copy machine for another year.

Glenn Fearon was in to see if Cindy could set up a meeting with North Country Council, the Selectmen and the Planning Board to discuss the Master plan.

Rolf Zuk was in to let the Selectmen know that he had updated the defib. In the hall and that it is not working as it needs new batteries. The Selectmen asked Rolf to pick up new batteries for it.

The Selectmen signed use of hall contracts for Anne Duffy and Delta Merchant.

The Selectmen met with the Trustees to go over polices. The Trustees have decided to meet on the 3rd Tuesday of every month at 8:00 P.M. at the town hall.

Bob Wormer made the motion to go into nonpublic session at 9:00 P.M. seconded by Bruce Frazer, both in favor. Bruce Frazer made the motion to come out of nonpublic session at 9:25P.M. Bob seconded, both in favor.

The Selectmen looked at the proposal Bryan Turnbull had emailed them on setting up a recycling program for next year. The Selectmen decided that this would have to be a petitioned warrant article. A petitioned warrant article will need signatures of at least 2% of the registered voters.

Cindy reminded the Selectmen that the next meeting will be on Monday November 30th at 7:00 P.M. and the Town Offices (both Selectmen's Office and Town Clerk's office) will be closed until November 30th.
